YOU CAN OVERCOME



Many Christians are prisoners of addictive behavior. And it's easy to feel overwhelmed and hopeless when you just can't seem to beat a habit. Letting go of your addictive behavior may feel like letting go of the very thing that helps you cope, gets you through each day, and sustains you. But it isn't truly sustaining you. It's pulling you under.

Drugs, extramarital sex, pornography, alcoholism, unhealthy relationships, negative self-talk, overwork, gluttony, gambling, overspending—these things can become the go-to coping mechanisms for life's pain, disappointments, and boredom. But they can leave you feeling trapped. The cure ultimately lies with you and God.

External religion without internal conversion has absolutely no value to God. He never intended for his people to simply memorize his word. He intends for us to keep it, and we can only do that when we are changed from the inside out.

To be set free from addictive behavior, you need to "be transformed by the renewing of your mind" (*Romans 12:2*). You need a new way of looking at yourself, God, others, and the things you do. Satan's strategy to keep you in addictive behavior is to mess with your mind. He wants to plant thoughts in your head, so they'll take root and bear deadly, destructive fruit in your actions. Remember that whoever or whatever controls your mind, also controls you.

God's Word does not automatically and immediately undo all of life's negative realities. Christians still face the same troubles as anyone else (John 16:33). But what God does provide is a sustaining hope. God is aware of your plight and is working on your behalf for good. No matter how dark your situation is, keep the faith because ultimately it will keep you.

Revelation 3:20: Jesus's statement, "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in," is used as an exercise of free will. It is up to the individual to open the door of their heart to Christ.

If you are still stuck deep in a pit, look for the lifeline—the tube—that God uses to send you what you need to sustain you as you wait on your breakthrough. He is Jehovah Jireh, our God who shall supply all our needs. And when the day comes for your victory, praise him. Praise the Lord because he saw you through what seemed like a hopeless situation. There is a promise from God: "Those who put their hope in me will not be put to shame" (*Isaiah 49:23*). So put your hope in God today. He sees you. He knows you. He loves you. He is with you. And he will deliver you when you trust him.

The great news is that you don't have to live a life of defeat, or a life in which you simply get by without maximizing all you were created to be. You can reclaim your spiritual authority. It is never too late. Start now.
